## 1. Chapter (1) Economically

The Corona virus is expected to cause a decrease in the rate of economic growth in Egypt and the world, and this is now clear because the rate of economic growth that was to be achieved by the end of the current fiscal year is 5.6%, that is, at the end of next June. But due to the current crisis, it is expected to reach 5.1% in the best case, with growth slowing in the third and fourth quarters to 5.2% and 4%, respectively. And that crisis will affect the rate of economic growth in the next fiscal year that begins in July 2020 and ends in June 2021, where it is expected to achieve an economic growth rate of 4.5% during the next fiscal year. If the Corona Virus outbreak ends, end of June will be sold. However, if the crisis were in the middle of 2021/2020, the targeted growth rate would decrease to 3.5%. Inflation could be expected to rise if the crisis was until December 2020, to 9.8% due to the excess demand for some products (medical supplies and detergents) and the limited increase in production capacity in the short term, as well as replaces production requirements from imports, despite the increase Expected in light of the second scenario, but it is still within the scope of the central bank's inflation target

## 2. Chapter (2) Tourism (Marsa Allam as quarantine area)

The city of Marsa Alam will be affected as a quarantine area in terms of tourism, because most of the hotels there have been turned into isolation rooms for returnees from abroad, and that will make it a medical area and not tourism, meaning that all those who profit from tourism will suffer from a very low income. ## 3. Chapter (3) Socially



## 6. Chapter (6) environmentally (less pollution Ozone depletion)

#### 6.1. Improved air quality

Because most of the industrial processes in the world have stopped, the air quality has started to improve significantly. Satellite images have shown a decrease in the concentration levels of nitrogen dioxide in the world, a toxic gas emitted mainly from car exhaust and factories, and one of the largest causes of air pollution in many of the cities.

#### 6.2. Carbon dioxide emissions decreased

The Corona crisis has also caused carbon dioxide in the air to drop worldwide. Thanks to the stopping of economic activity significantly in most countries, the rate of emission of this gas decreased, as happened before during the global financial crisis in 2008. In China alone, this gas concentration in the air decreased by 25 percent, according to what was reported by the "Carbon Brief" website, but this decrease it is expected to be for a temporary period until the economic activity returns to normal again.

#### 6.3. A new world for animals in empty cities

While humans were isolated in their homes to try to control the spread of corona, some animals were open to discovering the world in their absence. The lack of traffic in the streets saved the

young animals that started waking from their winter slumber like hedgehogs, from running under the wheels of cars. It is not excluded that ducks are currently wondering the reason for the absence of humans, as the lack of bread crumbs in the gardens has led to them and other birds having to find food on their own.

#### 6.7. Ignore the climate crisis




#### 6.8. The ozone layer is recovering
