Aim:



To identify & quantitatively analyze plants used as medicines at

Gilfena & surrounding villages,

El-Sharkaia governorate, Egypt.

Methods:

• What:

- Conducting direct interviews and semi-structured questionnaire with the local inhabitants at Gilfena & surrounding villages.
- Asking questions about the plants they use against diseases, parts of the plants used, methods of preparation and sources they obtain these plants.
- ➤ "How do you like using herbal medicines?"
- ➤ "Which part of the plant used?"
- ➤ "How do you prepare it?"
- ➤ "When do you use it?"
- ➤ "How often do you use it?"
- ➤ "What do you use it for?"
- ➤ "How does it affect you?"
- "Where do you obtain it from?"






Who:

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- ➤ Interviewers as students of the faculty of pharmacy directed by staff members from the Department of Medicinal Plants, Faculty of Pharmacy, HU.
- ➤ Interviewees as inhabitants of the villages, wit focus on the elders with a rural life style.



How:

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• Quantitative ethnobotanical assessment of the obtained data by calculating three parameters:

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- The factor informant consensus for the analysis of the general use of plants.
- The fidelity level, the ratio between the number of informants who
 independently suggest the use of a species for the same major purpose
 and the total number of informants who mention the plant for any use.
- Number of uses mentioned for one plant given by all of the informants for a specific disease.
